STEINER THEUSEN PLLC played a key role on the mutli-disciplinary design team for this project. The firm took the lead in the master planning phase developing a concept that was reminiscent of the original settlers that arrived in the area in wagons. The wagon wheel spokes serve as the main circulation routes tying the entire site together. A central planter and flagpoles are located at the hub of the wheel.

Several shelters and picnic tables were included in the design for use by travelers passing through or by local community members. The open field to the north of the site is used by little league football and soccer teams. Irrigation water is supplied by two fully automated well pumps that are programmed to work in unison. Construction value of the landscape architectural component of the project was approximately \$600,000.
