The Park at Ucross was envisioned as a collection of interesting and varied outdoor rooms, linked together by an informal system of trails and interstitial green space. These outdoor places for park users include developed site settings enveloping the chapel and Plank Library and a large, central circular lawn that could host a variety





of functions and activities. Defined by earth forms, tree groves and sustainable landscaping, a wildflower meadow, perennial garden, and picnic area round out the major outdoor rooms. Opportunities were created within the design for contributions by the program residents, including sculpture and land art installations, or performances. The design intent was to create a memorable and special green space within the overall ranch setting for events, for use by the artists in residence, and for use by the neighbors and greater community.
